TERMS OF USE OF PHOTOGRAPHS OWNED BY
BLOUNT COUNTY PUBLIC LIBRARY

The **Copyright Law** of the United States (Title 17, United States Code) governs the making of photographs and other reproductions of copyrighted material. One of the specified conditions is that the photograph or reproduction is not to be used “for any purpose other than private study, scholarship, or research.” Therefore, images from library-owned special collections may be downloaded from the appropriate BCPL website for individual or educational use such as personal websites, school reports, and similar non-commercial ventures without written permission and the payment of a use fee.

However, written BCPL permission and the payment of a fee are required for **ANY OTHER USE** by individuals, non-profit organizations, and businesses. This use is subject to the following conditions:

- 1) Permission to publish, broadcast, or display is granted only insofar as the rights of BCPL are concerned.
- 2) In many cases BCPL possesses only physical ownership of material in its collections and does not own copyright or other intellectual property rights to this material. In such cases, all responsibility for possible copyright infringement arising from use of reproductions of this material will be assumed by the requesting party.
- 3) Permission to reproduce materials is granted for one-time use only. Any reuse of the materials without permission is forbidden. This permission is not transferable to any other party.
- 4) Alterations to the original image are not allowed.
- 5) A credit line, as stated below, must appear in an appropriate position in the display, publication, or filming of the image. The following wording must be used: **“Blount County Public Library, Maryville, Tennessee”**.
- 6) Failure to comply with any of the above regulations will result in the withdrawal of permission to reproduce or display, and appropriate legal action will be taken.

Blount County Public Library reserves the right to limit access to its historic photograph collection based on the physical condition of an item, donor requirements, or other circumstances. Original photographs from the collection are not available for in-library viewing, photographing, or videotaping.
