

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING. In accordance with Tennessee Code Annotated Sections 5-5-105 and 13-7-105, the Board of County Commissioners of Blount County, Tennessee, will hold public hearing on September 11, 2018, at 6:00 P.M., at the Blount County Courthouse Commission Meeting Room for the following proposed amendment to the Zoning Resolution of Blount County, Tennessee, being Resolution 18-09-012. **A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE ZONING RESOLUTION OF BLOUNT COUNTY, TENNESSEE, ARTICLE 13 DEFINITIONS OF INDOOR AND OUTDOOR SPORT SHOOTING RANGES, PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 13-7-101, et seq., TENNESSEE CODE ANNOTATED AND HAVING ALREADY BEEN ADOPTED AS PART OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE (RESOLUTION 00-06-010).**

That the definitions of Indoor Sport Shooting Range and Outdoor Sport Shooting Range be amended to read as follows:

INDOOR SPORT SHOOTING RANGE: a fully enclosed building or part of building specifically designed and operated for the use of rifles, shotguns, pistols, silhouettes, skeet, trap, black powder, archery, or any other shooting activity, which is: (a) held out to the public as a commercial enterprise; (b) open to the public (even if a membership is required); or (c) operated at any time for the purpose of generating a profit. Notwithstanding the foregoing, “Indoor Sport Shooting Range” shall not include any police or military firing ranges operated by any level of government or any ranges upon which occasional not-for-profit charitable events (commonly called “turkey shoots”) take place.

OUTDOOR SPORT SHOOTING RANGE: an outdoor area, not enclosed in a building, designed and operated for the use of rifles, shotguns, pistols, silhouettes, skeet, trap, black powder, archery, or any other shooting activity, which is: (a) held out to the public as a commercial enterprise; (b) open to the public (even if a membership is required); or (c) operated at any time for the purpose of generating a profit. Notwithstanding the foregoing, “Outdoor Sport Shooting Range” shall not include any police or military firing ranges operated by any level of government or any ranges upon which occasional not-for-profit charitable events (commonly called “turkey shoots”) take place.
