What can I put in the Cardboard Container?

- Clean corrugated cardboard ONLY

What Does NOT Go Into The Cardboard Container?

- NO Soiled Pizza boxes
- NO Soiled cardboard
- No pasteboard boxes. ex. Cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc.

What Can I Put In The Single Stream Recycling Cart?

- Junk Mail, Magazines, Catalogs and Phone Books
- Metal Cans: Aluminum, Steel
- Office and School Paper
- Paper Bags
- Plastics #1 through #7
- Waxed Cartons. Ex. ice cream, coffee cups, juice/milk
- Cereal boxes, shoe boxes, pizza Boxes

What Does NOT Go Into The Single Stream Recycling Cart?

- NO Batteries of any kind
- NO Bubble Wrap OR any plastic you can wad up in your hand
- NO Chemicals
- NO Diapers
- NO Food soiled paper products (such as pizza boxes)
- NO Household Hazardous Waste
- NO Kitchen Waste
- NO Oil
- NO Paint
- NO Plastic Bags
- NO GLASS BOTTLES
- NO Plastic Takeout Containers and Utensils
- NO Styrofoam
- NO Tires
- NO Trash
- NO Yard Waste

What Can I Put in the Paint and Bulb Containers?

- 4ft and 8ft Intact Fluorescent Bulbs
- Oil Based Paints and Stains

What Does NOT go into the Paint and Bulb Containers?

- Broken Bulbs
- Incandescent Bulbs
- LED Bulbs
- Latex Paints (must be dried and placed in landfill)

What Can I put in the Newspaper Container?

- Newsprint only

What can I put in the Glass dumpsters?

- Glass only, NO trash please

Household Hazardous Waste

Acceptable Items

- oil and fuel additives
- grease and rust solvents, naval jelly
- carburetor and fuel injector cleaners
- starter fluids
- body putty
- antifreeze / coolant
- gasoline (in approved container which **MUST** be left)
- used strippers and thinners
- adhesives
- driveway sealant
- roofing tar
- wallpaper remover
- pesticides
- fertilizers
- wood preservatives

- pool chemicals
- photo processing chemicals
- aerosols / compressed gas
- mercury thermostats and thermometers
- 4 and 8ft fluorescent tubes
- needles and sharps (in a puncture-proof container)

Unacceptable Items

- infectious wastes
- dead animals
- any waste from a doctor's office, clinic, or veterinarian's office

- fireworks
- military ordnance
- gun powder
- ammunition
- smoke detectors
- radium paint

- no businesses, large or small
- no colleges or universities
- no schools
- no hospitals
- no home improvement or painting contractors
- no agribusiness

- empty containers of any kind
- automotive gas tanks
- alkaline batteries - may be thrown away in the trash
- electronics – contact your local Solid Waste Department for guidance
