WHAT TO DO AFTER YOU REPORT A WORKPLACE INJURY



SEEK TREATMENT WITH PANEL PHYSICIAN

The physician you choose from the Panel is your authorized treating physician for as long as necessary or appropriate. If you choose to see a physician that is not on the Panel, Workers' Compensation cannot authorize or pay for the doctor visit/treatment. All treatment must be Pre-authorized.



PRESCRIPTION MUST BE FILLED AT BLOUNT DISCOUNT PHARMACY

To avoid out of pocket expense, Blount Discount Pharmacy will provide you with a temporary Instant Rx card from Guardian RX that will expire 7 days from your first fill. A permanent card will be sent to you in the mail from Guardian RX and you can fill approved subsequent work comp prescriptions at any participating pharmacy with no out of pocket expense.



RETURN TO WORK FORM TO SUPERVISOR AND RISK MANAGEMENT

The physician will provide you with your current work status that you give to your supervisor and Risk Management. There are three options for Return to Work.

1. Full Duty - you may return to your normal job duties
2. Restricted Duty - you cannot perform your normal job duties and may be given alternative job duties or be placed on light duty
3. No Work - you cannot return to work at this time. After a 7 day waiting period you may receive TTD benefits.



YOU HAVE A CLAIMS ADJUSTER WITH CHARLES TAYLOR TPA

You may be contacted by your adjuster, it is important to speak with them. You will receive a packet from Charles Taylor TPA containing important information as well as paperwork to complete and return.
