Rules & Guidelines

You will be judged on four criteria: Craftsmanship, Creativity, Skill Level, and General Presentation, with a bonus category of Stage Presence. We will announce the winners after everyone has walked.

A few rules for entering the cosplay contest do apply:

- Anyone who competes in the cosplay contest **MUST** participate in the cosplay prejudging session! This makes everything much smoother for all contestants and attendees. This will take place from 12:45 - 2:15 PM in the BCPL Board Room. Contestants will have 1 - 3 minutes each with the judges to show off their costumes and briefly discuss their handmade elements.
- Your costume must have a handmade element to it. Something small, or something big—either way, we're excited to see it.
- No throwing anything or running into the audience during your walk.
- Blount County Public Library is a family-friendly location. As such, your cosplay/costume should be PG-13 max, and you should be respectful of all attendees and contestants with your words and actions.
- Profanity and anything deemed racially or culturally offensive will not be allowed. Politically charged and/or discriminatory cosplays or props will not be allowed. Anyone breaking these rules will be disqualified and removed from the contest.
